On Friday, Oct 17, 2008 – Georgia State Frisbee Dog Championships ~ 2pm-7pm - (12pm onsite registration Qualifier open to the public) - Two Divisions: Super-Open Freestyle and Super-Pro Toss & Fetch will be offered as open division Qualifiers for Saturday’s US National Finals.

On Saturday, Oct 18, 2008 – USDDN US Disc Dog National Finals ~ 10am-6pm - (9am onsite registration) - One National Finals Division: Super-Open Freestyle will be offered on Saturday with 3 other divisions open to the public – Division II Freestyle, Pro T&F Fetch, and Novice Toss & Fetch. Teams from 6 USA Qualifiers, 1 Canada, 3 European Qualifiers, and 2 Japan Qualifiers will all go head to head for the US National Finals title. The top 15 US National Finals Super-Open Freestyle winners today will advance to the Sunday International Finals.

On Sunday, Oct 19, 2008 – USDDN Disc Dog International Finals ~ 2pm-7pm - Two Divisions: US National Finals Super-Pro Toss & Fetch teams from all over the world will go head to head for advancement to the afternoon International Finals Super-Pro Toss & Fetch rounds. The International Finals Super-Open Freestyle rounds will be the high light of the weekend as the best of the best go head to head for the International Finals Titles.

Georgia State Dog Agility Championships – Sunday Only ~ 10-6pm – (Open to the public onsite registration at 9am). This is the first ever Dog Agility Georgia State Champions will crown the GA State Dog Agility Champion in 3 different height divisions. A standard course will be managed and judged by Chris McLeod of The Canine Ranch.

Competitors will be traveling from around the World (9 different countries) vying for the GA State, US National Finals, and International Finals title. If your dog can chase a Frisbee disc or a ball then you can entry Saturday’s Novice Toss & Fetch (Beginner Division). Spectators invited to watch free all three days. All dog enthusiasts are invited to come whether you compete or just watch will enjoy the fun filled day. Come watch the World’s best Frisbee Dogs, and Agility Dogs vie for the GA State title, US National Finals title and the International Finals title.

Directions to Dellinger Park from Atlanta, GA: Take I-75 north to exit 283 Emerson/Allatoona Road, turn left off the exit going 9/10 mile, (pass under I-75 bridge and then under the US 41 bridge), and turn left onto Old Alabama Road, travel 4.1 miles and turn right onto Douthit Ferry Road, travel 1.3 miles to stop sign and turn right onto Pine Grove Road, travel 4/10 mile and park will be on the right, follow the road all the way straight back to the football/soccer field.
